## Aunt Daisy's Quilt

Block Unit B - Quarter Square Triangle block unit $41 / 2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ unfinished.

For every TWO Block Units B you will need the following:
MC: Cut 1: $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Background: Cut 1: $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ square.


Directions: Quarter Square Triangle block units are made by placing two oversized squares, one MC (Main Color) and one BC (Background Color) together.


Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner.


Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away on each side of the drawn line.


Cut on the drawn line.


You now have two Half Square Triangle units. Press to the dark side.


Now, Place these back together with MC against Background Color. Nesting the seams up against each other.


Draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner (the unsewn diagonal corners).


Again, sew $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ away from the drawn line on both side of the line.


Cut on the drawn line and press open.



Use your ruler to trim each quarter square triangle unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ making sure the diagonal corners are lined up perfectly from corner to corner.


Your unit should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.


TO TRIM WITH A REGULAR RULER: You will use $41 / 2 "$ on the ruler and trim on two sides first making sure you line up on the diagonal with the center cross points at $21 / /^{\prime \prime}$ and $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.


Then, trim on the other two sides making sure you line up on the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lines on both sides of the ruler as shown below. The center cross point is still lined up on the $21 / 4$ " and $21 / 4 "$ intersecting lines.



Please Note: The yardage and directions are very generous and based on 40 " wide fabric. I suggest you cut one strip and cut out your squares to see how many squares you get from each strip before cutting all of the strips.

For every ONE BC and MC square you will get TWO quarter square triangles.

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King Size Quilt: Required 64 Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 6 strips 6 " $\times$ WOF - Sub cut into $32-6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Background: Cut 6 strips 6" x WOF - Sub cut into 32-6" x 6" squares.
Queen Size Quilt: Required 48 Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 4 strips 6" x WOF - Sub cut into 24-6" x 6" squares.
Background: Cut 4 strips 6" x WOF - Sub cut into 24-6" x 6" squares.
Double Size Quilt: Required 36 Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 \prime$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 3 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub cut into $18-6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Background: Cut 3 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub cut into $18-6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Twin Size Quilt: Required $\mathbf{2 4}$ Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 21 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub cut into $12-6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Background: Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub cut into 12- $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Lap Size Quilt: Required 16 Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub cut into $8-6 "$ x 6 " squares.
Background: Cut 2 strips 6" x WOF - Sub cut into 8-6" x 6" squares.

Table Topper/Pillow Front Size : Required 4 Quarter Square Triangle block units: $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

MC: Cut 2-6" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Background: Cut 2-6" x 6" squares.
